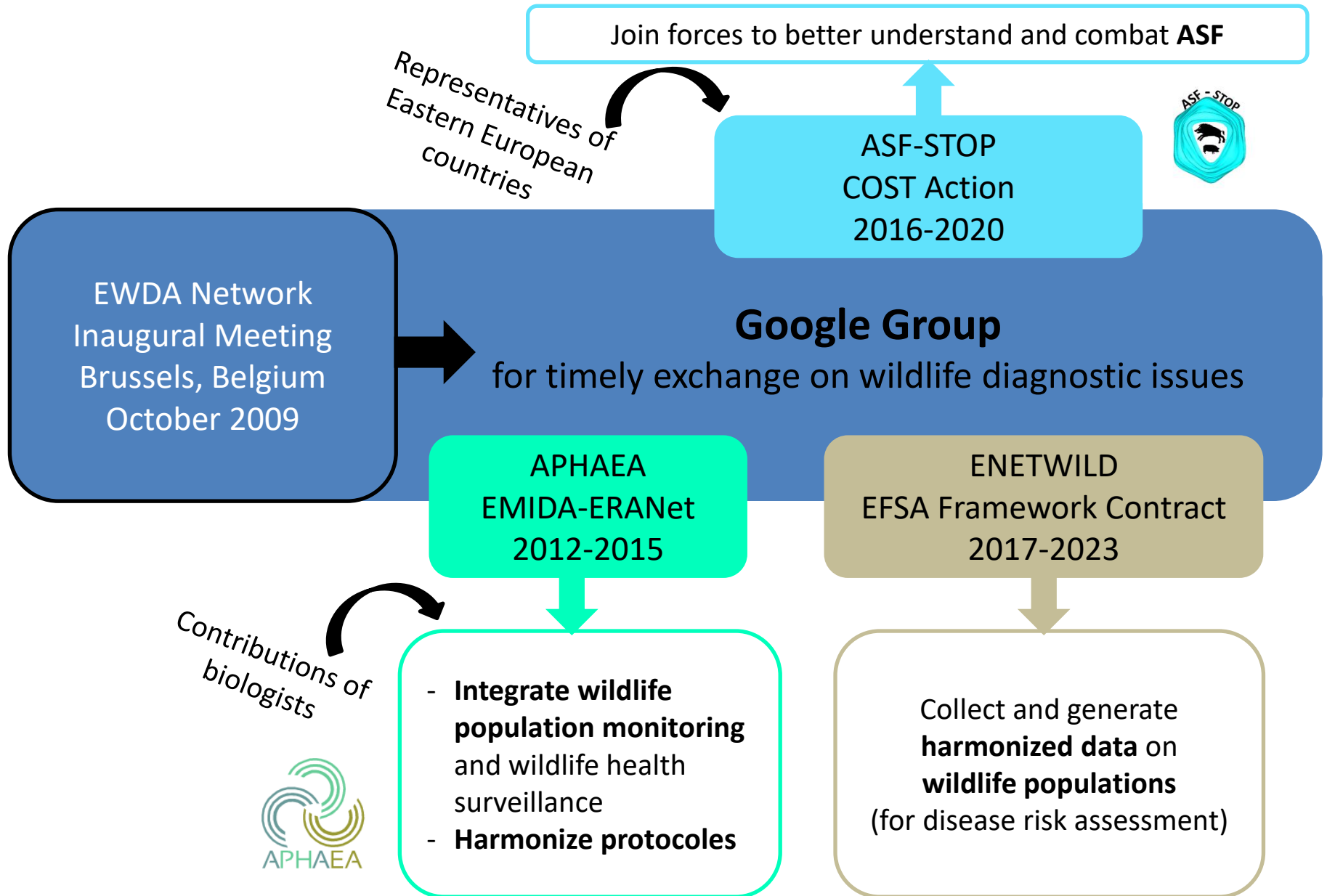

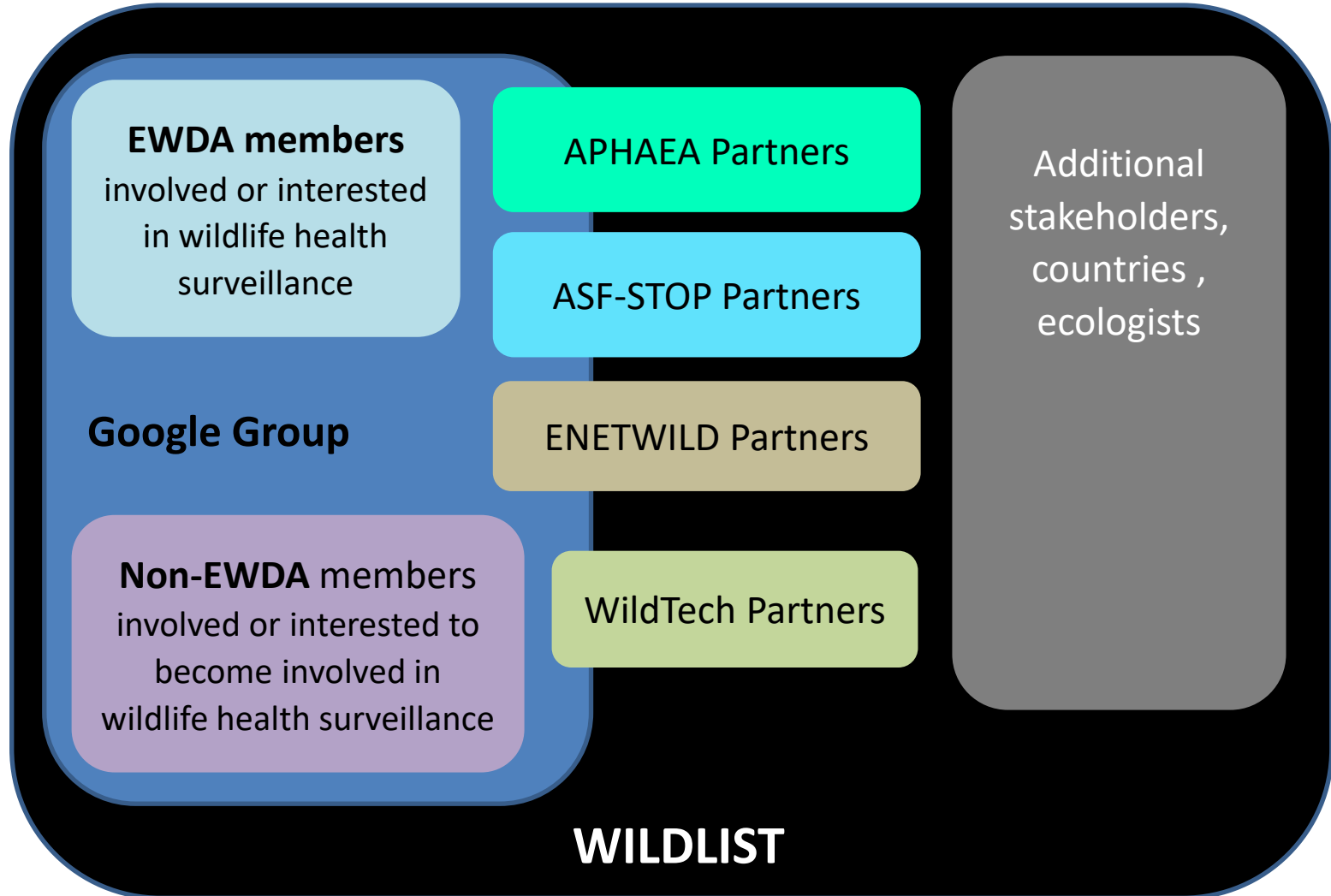

What:

- **all invited to register**: Google group members, APHAEA partners, ASF-STOP partners, ENETWILD partners, all other wildlife health experts in Europe
- **member's profile**: basic data on area of expertise
- possibility to **update** one's profile at any time

Why:

- **easier to find colleagues** with specific interest and expertise
- **broader range of expertise and type of information** exchanged, incl. meeting, courses, job advertisements
- **Google group = subgroup** dedicated to wildlife disease detection in Europe
